

## Block 4 – Mieke Duyck

### General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ), rounded to 15 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) all around.

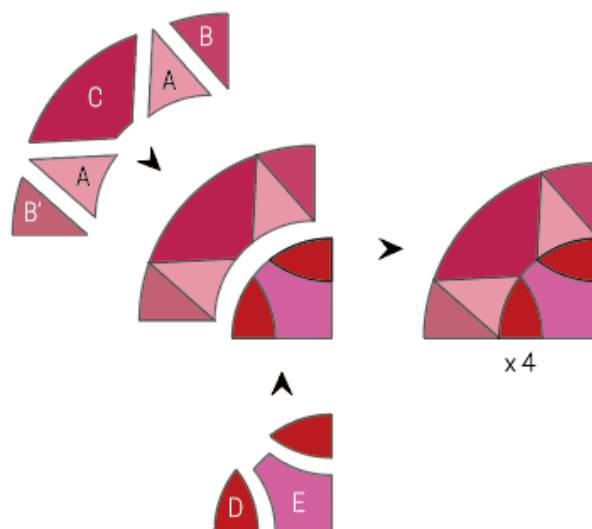
### Cutting :

- From one pale pink fabric, cut the following:
  - eight A pieces
- From one assortment of solid pink fabrics, in total:
  - four B pieces and four B' pieces (reverse template B)
  - four C pieces
- From one red fabric with pink polka dots:
  - eight D pieces
- From two red and pink fabrics:
  - two E pieces from each fabric
- From one grey fabric for the background:
  - one 26.5 cm ( $10\frac{1}{2}$ " ) F square
- From one bright pink fabric (or from scraps):
  - eight G circles

### Assembly :

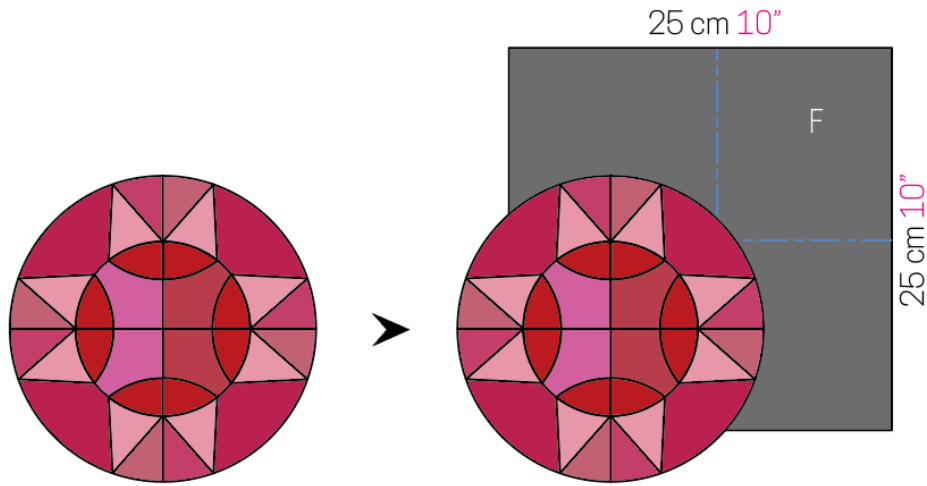
**Diagram 1:** Stitch one A piece to either side of one C piece. Add one B piece to the right side and one B' piece to the left.

Stitch one D piece to either side of one E piece. Insert this unit into the previous unit. Repeat to obtain four units.



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**Diagram 2:** Stitch these units together in twos and join them. Centre and appliqué the unit on your F background square.



**Diagram 3:** Appliqué one G circle at each of the points of the A pieces.
