

Block 10 - Emma Neman

General instructions:

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($^{1}/_{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($^{1}/_{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($^{1}/_{4}$ ") all around. Cutting key:

⊠: Square cut on the two diagonals

For those using the traditional cutting method, note that you wil find:

- the templates on the pattern; add seam allowances to them
- the quantities **in bold** in the Cutting section

Cutting:

- From an assortment of four pink fabrics:
 - o one A octagon of each fabric
- From one fabric, raspberry semi-solid, cut the following:
 - o one 4.5 cm $(1^3/4'')$ B square
 - o four D pieces
- From one black and white fabric:
 - o one 7.7 cm (3") square, \boxtimes to yield four C triangles
- From one white fabric with small flowers:
 - o four E pieces

QUILTmania

Assembly:

Diagram 1: Stitch one A octagon to either side of the B square. Stitch one C triangle to either side of the two remaining A octagons and join them to the top and bottom of the previous unit.




Diagram 2: Stitch one E piece to two opposite sides of the previous unit. Stitch one D piece to either side of the remaining E pieces and complete your block.
