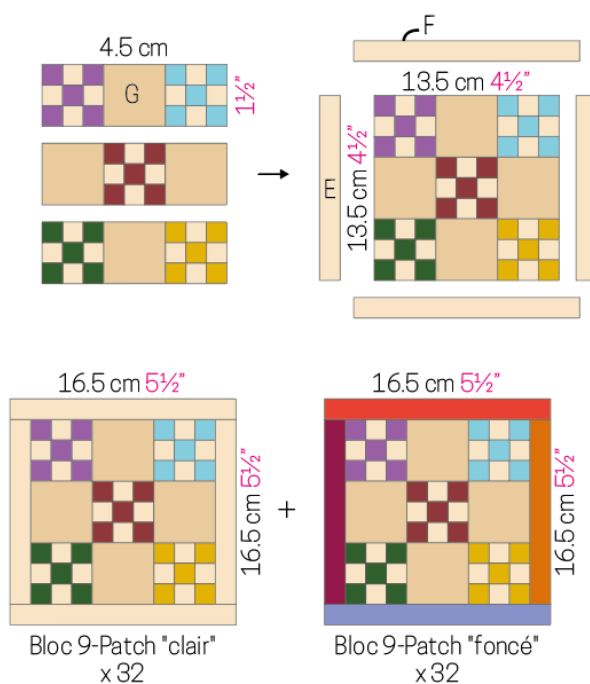


QUILT *mania* Inc.

QM N°139 – Country Courthouse Erratum

Use the following for diagram #3:



For the 32 light-coloured 9-Patch blocks:

From one fabric from the light-coloured assortment:

- Four 2" (6 cm) G squares

From four other fabrics from the light-coloured assortment, cut per block:

- Two 1" x 5" (3 x 15 cm) E strips
- Two 1" x 6" (3 x 18 cm) F strips

For the 32 dark-coloured 9-Patch blocks:

From one fabric from the light-coloured assortment:

- Four 2" (6 cm) G squares
- From four other fabrics from the dark-coloured assortment, cut in total:
 - Two 1" x 5" (3 x 15 cm) E strips
 - Two 1" x 6" (3 x 18 cm) F strips

Make five 9-Patch blocks of different fabrics and assemble them in three rows, alternating them with the G squares to obtain one double 9-Patch block.

Stitch one E strip to either side and complete the block with one F strip on the top and bottom.

Following these instructions, make the following:

- 32 light-coloured double 9-Patch blocks with the light-coloured E and F strips
- 32 dark-coloured double 9-Patch blocks with the dark-coloured E and F strips
