

Block 20 – Jane Gregory

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

Cutting :

- From one raspberry fabric, cut the following:
 - four 4 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ ") C squares
- From one assortment of three raspberry gradient fabrics:
 - one 4 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ ") C square of each fabric
- From one pink fabric:
 - one 9 cm ($3\frac{1}{2}$ ") A square
- From a second pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 9 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") B rectangles
- From a third pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 11.5 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ") D rectangles
- From a fourth pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 14 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ") E rectangles
- From a fifth pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 16.5 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ") F rectangles
- From a sixth pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 19 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ ") G rectangles
- From a seventh pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 21.5 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ") H rectangles
- From an eighth pink fabric:
 - two 4 x 24 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ") I rectangles

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Refer to the pattern to arrange the different fabrics of the C squares. Stitch one B rectangle to the left side of the A square. Add one C square to the left side of the remaining B rectangle and join this unit to the top. Stitch one D rectangle to the left side of the previous unit. Add one C square to the left side of the remaining D rectangle and join this unit to the top. Stitch one E rectangle to the left side of the previous unit. Add one C square to the left side of the remaining E rectangle and join this unit to the top.

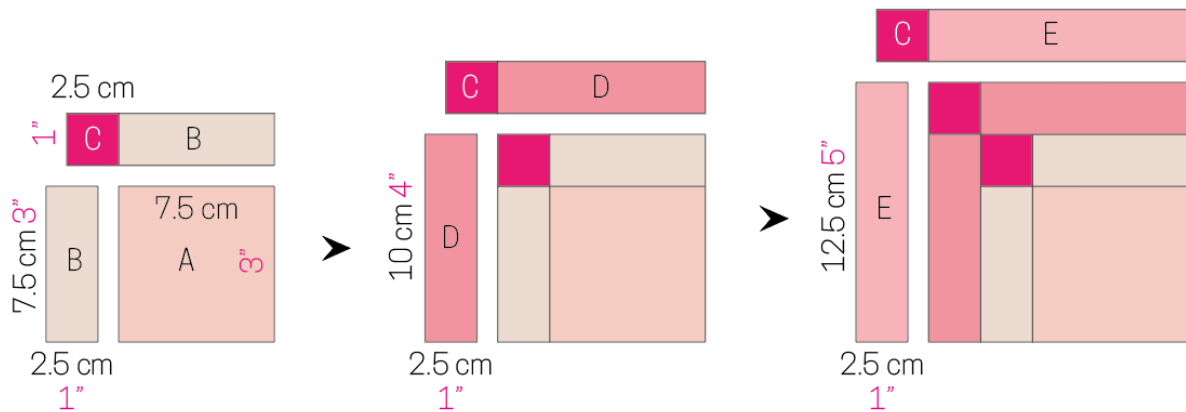


Diagram 2: Continue in the same way with the F, G, H and I rectangles to make your block.
