

Block 36 – Sophie Dawson

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify " *Seam allowances included" . For the appliqués, add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.

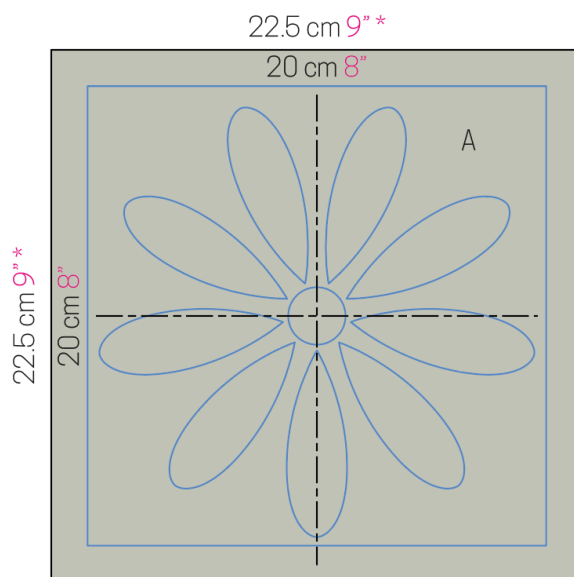
Cutting :

- From one stripe fabric for the background, cut the following:
 - one 22.5 cm (9") A square; extra fabric is allowed when cutting to facilitate working the appliqués
- From an assortment of pink fabrics:
 - twenty-three 4 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
- From one beige fabric:
 - one circle 1
- From an assortment of three purple and pink fabrics:
 - three of petal 2 from each fabric
 - thirteen 4 cm ($1\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Mark one 20 x 20 cm (8" x 8") square on the right side of the A square. Using a light source, transfer the motif outlines.

Diagram 2: Work the appliqués using the traditional method as follows: pin or baste the various pieces in place on the background square, turning your seam allowance to the back.

Then appliqué the elements with small invisible stitches.

Recut the appliqué block to 21.5 x 21.5 cm (8¹/₂" x 8¹/₂"), seam allowances included.

Stitch two columns of eight B squares and join them to either side of the centre square.

Stitch two rows of ten B squares and complete the block, joining these rows to the top and bottom.
