

Block 49 – Linda Guy

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the appliqué, add your preferred seam allowance around the template.

Cutting :

- From one beige semi-solid fabric, cut the following:
 - one 9.5 cm ($3\frac{1}{2}$ ") A square
 - two 2 x 25.5 cm (1 " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ") C strips
 - two 2 x 26.5 cm (1 " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ ") D strips
- From one bright pink fabric:
 - one heart
- From an assortment of many pink and red fabrics:
 - twenty-three 5.5 cm (2 ") B squares

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Appliqué the heart in the centre of the A square, using the traditional method as follows: turn your seam allowance to the back and work small invisible stitches.

Stitch two rows of two B squares.

Join the rows.

Repeat and join these four-patch blocks to either side of the appliqué A square.

Stitch two rows of six B squares and join the rows. Repeat and join them to the top and bottom of the previous unit.

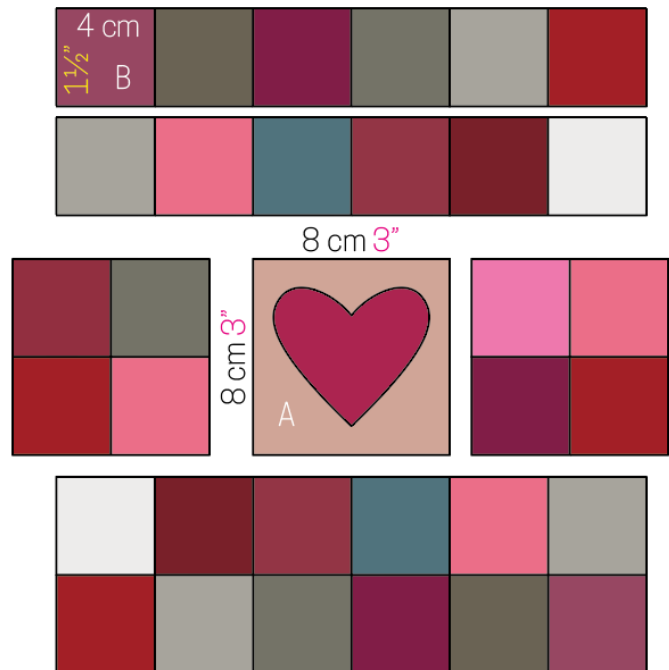


Diagram 2: Stitch one C strip to the right and left sides and complete the final border with one D strip on the top and bottom.
