

Block 54 – Sharon Keightley

General instructions :

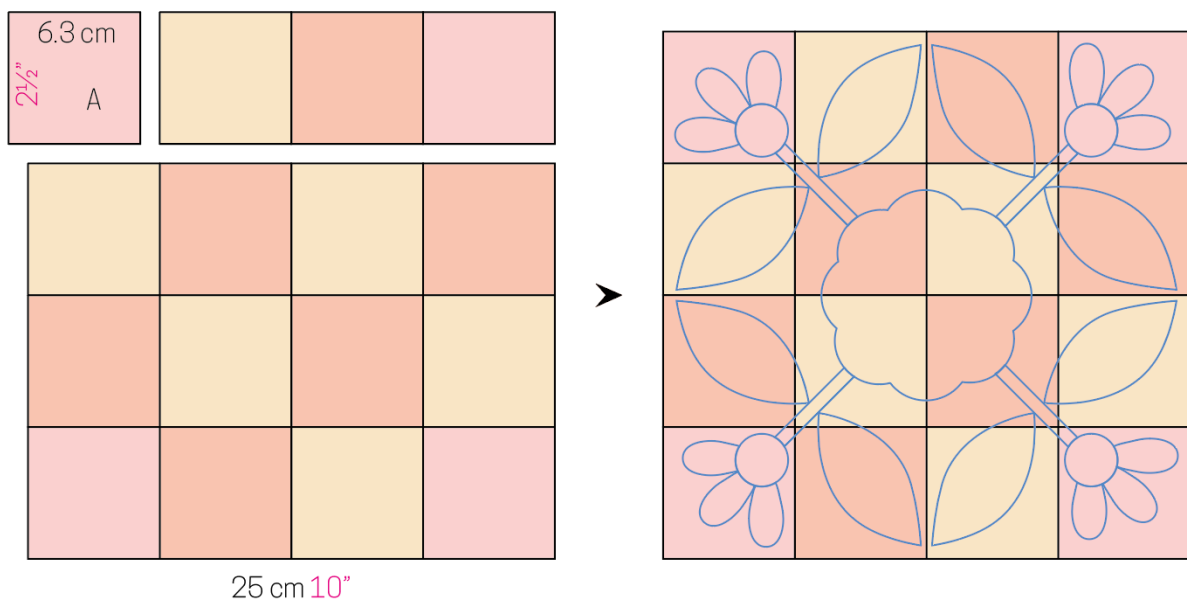
The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments. The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the appliqués, add your preferred seam allowance around the templates.

Cutting :

- From an assortment of three ecru fabrics for the background, cut the following:
 - from one fabric: four 7.8 cm (3") A squares
 - from the second and third fabrics: six 7.8 cm (3") A squares
- From an assortment of two pink fabrics and two red fabrics:
 - the various appliqué elements, using the templates

Assembly :

Diagram 1: Referring to the diagram to position each fabric, stitch four rows of four A squares and join the rows to make the block background. Using a light source, transfer the motif outlines.



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Diagram 2: Work the appliqués using the traditional method as follows: pin or baste the various pieces in place on the background square, turning your seam allowance to the back.

Then appliqué the elements with small invisible stitches.
