

## Block 66 – Claire Cazali

### General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ), rounded to 15 mm ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

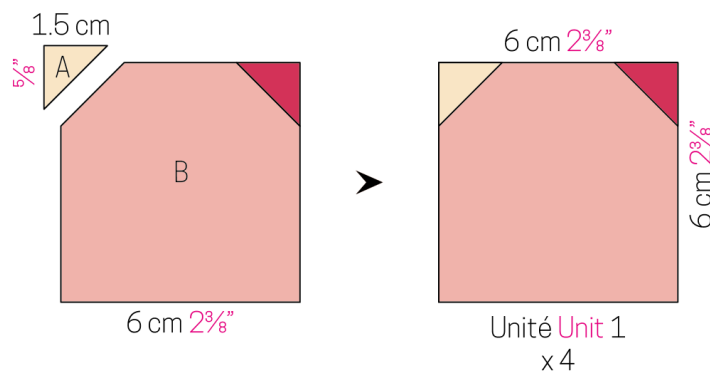
The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances. For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) all around.

### Cutting :

- From one beige fabric for the background, cut the following:
  - four A triangles
  - two C triangles
  - two D triangles
  - two 7.5 cm ( $2\frac{7}{8}$ " ) F squares
- From one pink fabric for the flower centre:
  - four A triangles
- From a second pink fabric for the flower:
  - four B pieces
- From one red fabric for the leaves:
  - two C triangles
- From a third pink fabric for the stem:
  - one E piece
- From a fourth pink fabric to border the block:
  - four G triangles

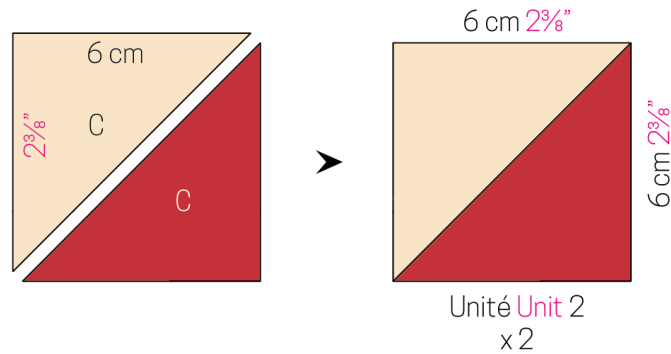
### Assembly :

**Diagram 1:** Stitch one A triangle of each fabric to the corners of one B piece. Repeat to obtain four of Unit 1 in total.

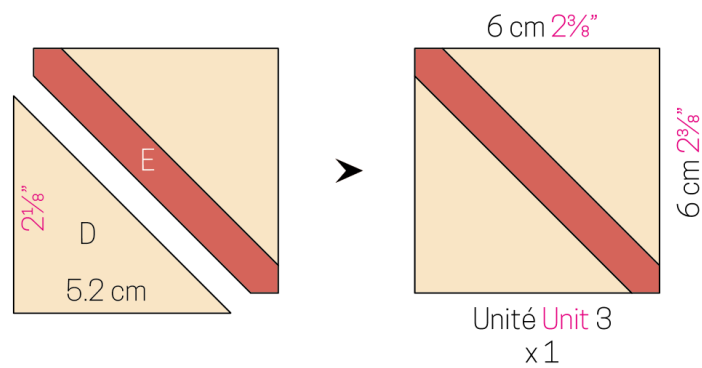


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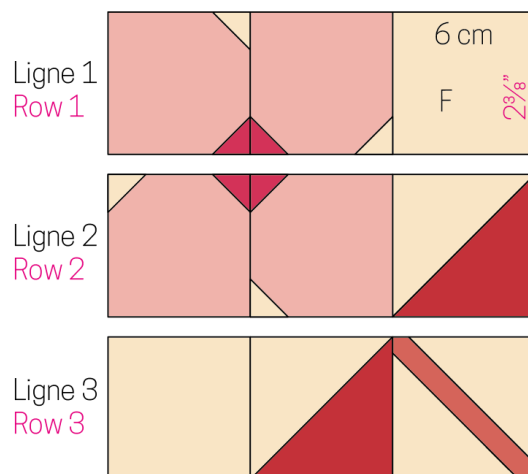
**Diagram 2:** Join the contrasting C squares in twos to obtain two of Unit 2.



**Diagram 3:** Stitch one D triangle to either side of the E piece to obtain one Unit 3.



**Diagram 4:** Join your units and the two F squares in three rows, referring to the diagram to position and orient each one.



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**Diagram 5:** Stitch one G triangle to each side of the previous unit to complete your block.
