

Block 74 – Corinne Orillon

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "Seam allowances included".

For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

For those using the traditional cutting method, note that you will find:

- the templates on the pattern; add seam allowances to them
- the quantities in **bold** in the Cutting section

Cutting :

- From one medium pink fabric, cut the following:
 - two 7.8 cm (**3"**) squares, to yield **two A triangles**
 - two 7.8 cm (**3"**) C squares
- From one red fabric with polka dots:
 - two 7.8 cm (**3"**) squares, to yield **two A triangles**
 - two 7.8 cm (**3"**) C squares
 - two 4 x 17.5 cm (**$1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{3}{4}$ "**) rectangles, to yield **two D pieces**
- From one pink fabric with large flowers:
 - two 7.8 x 14 cm (**3 " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "**) rectangles, to yield **two B triangles**
- From one beige fabric:
 - two 7.8 cm (**3"**) squares, to yield **two A triangles**
 - two 7.8 x 14 cm (**3 " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "**) F rectangles
- From one cream fabric:
 - **one E piece**

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Assembly :

Diagram 1: Place one medium pink square and one red square, right sides together and edge to edge, in each top corner of one rectangle of pink fabric with large flowers. Stitch along the diagonals of each square and cut away the excess fabric at 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") from the seam.

Add one C square of the same two fabrics to either side of the flying geese block obtained.

Repeat these steps to obtain two units in total.

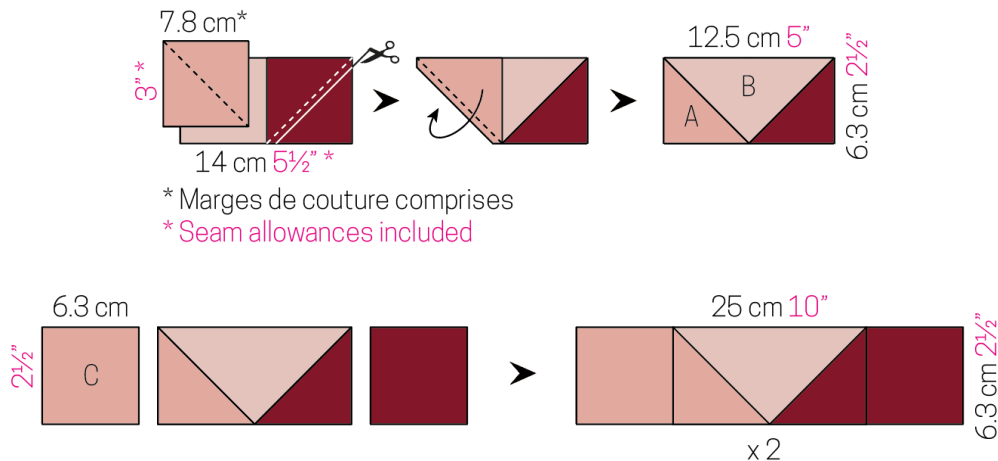
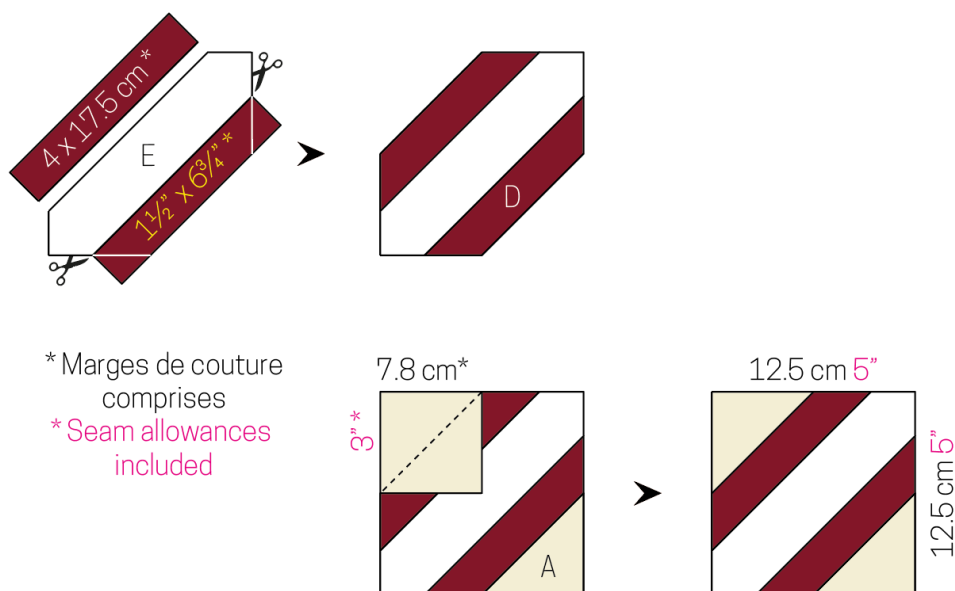


Diagram 2: Stitch one red-fabric strip to either side of the E piece. Cut away the excess fabric at 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") from the seam, to obtain the D pieces. Stitch one beige square, on its diagonal, in the opposite corners of this unit. Cut away the excess fabric to obtain two A triangles on either side of the unit.



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Diagram 3: Stitch one F rectangle to either side of the previous unit. Complete the block with one unit on the top and bottom.
