

## Block 77 – Blandine Delépine

### General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ), rounded to 15 mm ( $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "Seam allowances included".

For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " ) all around.

### Cutting :

Number your fabrics for easier identification.

- From Fabric 1, red with flowers, cut the following:
  - eight A triangles
  - two 2.8 x 24 cm ( $1" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ ) J strips
  - two 2.8 x 26.5 cm ( $1" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ ) K strips
- From Fabric 2, beige:
  - eight A triangles
  - one 9 cm ( $3\frac{1}{2}"$ ) B square
- From Fabric 3, red with small checks:
  - four 9 cm ( $3\frac{1}{2}"$ ) B squares
- From Fabric 4, red with small motifs:
  - three C rectangles
  - four E rectangles
  - one H roof
  - one I chimney
- From Fabric 5, ecru with stripes:
  - one D door
  - one F window
  - one G roof

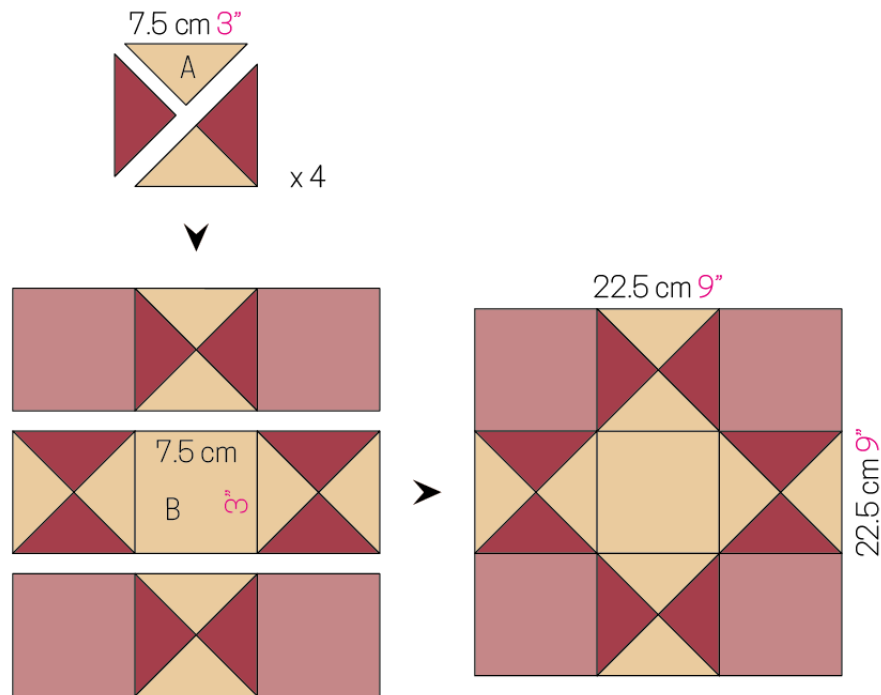
# QUILTmania

## Assembly :

**Diagram 1:** Stitch together the contrasting A triangles in twos, then join them to obtain four bicolour hourglass blocks.

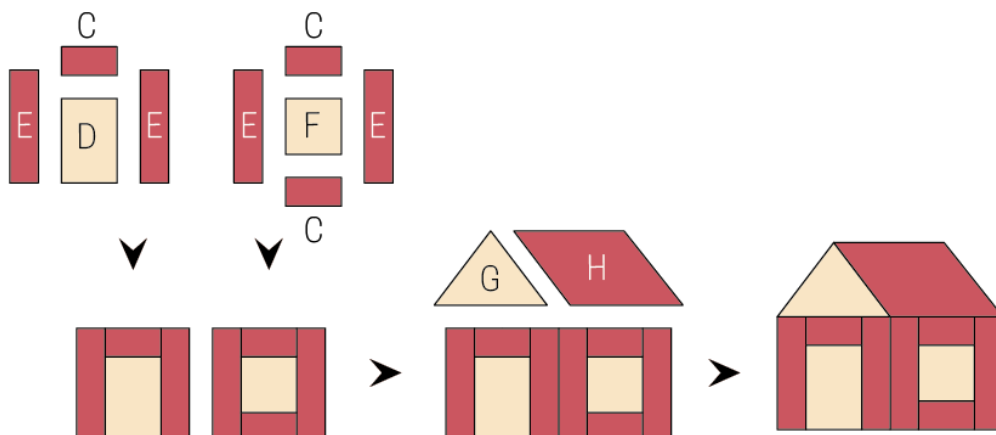
Stitch one bicolour hourglass block to either side of the beige B square.

Stitch one red B square to either side of the remaining bicolour hourglass blocks and join the rows obtained to the top and bottom of the previous unit.



**Diagram 2:** Stitch one C rectangle to the top of the D door. Add one E rectangle to either side. Stitch one C rectangle to the top and bottom of the F window. Add one E rectangle to either side. Join these units.

Stitch together the G and H roof pieces and add this unit to the previous to make the centre appliqué.

**Diagram 3:** Position and pin chimney I then repeat for the house. Work traditional appliqué, with small running stitches.  
Stitch one J strip to the top and bottom. Complete the outer border with one K strip on the left and right sides.
