

Block 79 – Robin Long

General instructions :

The measurements given for cutting include seam allowances of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ "), rounded to 15 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") for two seams. Make any necessary adjustments.

The measurements in the explanatory diagrams do not include seam allowances, except for those diagrams that specify "Seam allowances included".

For the templates, add a seam allowance of 7 mm ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") all around.

Cutting :

Number your fabrics for easier identification.

- From Assortment 1 of four cream fabrics, cut the following:
 - from the first fabric: two 9 cm ($3\frac{1}{2}$ ") A squares
 - from the second fabric: two 9 cm ($3\frac{1}{2}$ ") A squares
 - from the third fabric: four 6.5 cm ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
 - from the fourth fabric: four 6.5 cm ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
- From Assortment 2 of three red fabrics:
 - from the first fabric: two 6.5 cm ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
 - from the second fabric: two 6.5 cm ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
 - from the third fabric: one D piece
- From Assortment 3 of two pink fabrics:
 - from the first fabric: four 6.5 cm ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") B squares
 - from the second fabric: one C piece and one C' piece (reverse template C)

QUILTmania

Assembly :

Diagram 1: Join the A squares of different fabrics in twos, then stitch them together to obtain one four-patch block.

Referring to the diagram to arrange the fabrics, stitch one column composed of two cream B squares separated by one pink B square. Repeat and join these columns to either side of your four-patch block.

Stitch one row with the same squares used for the columns (two cream B squares and one pink B square), adding one red B square to each end.

Repeat and join these rows to the top and bottom.

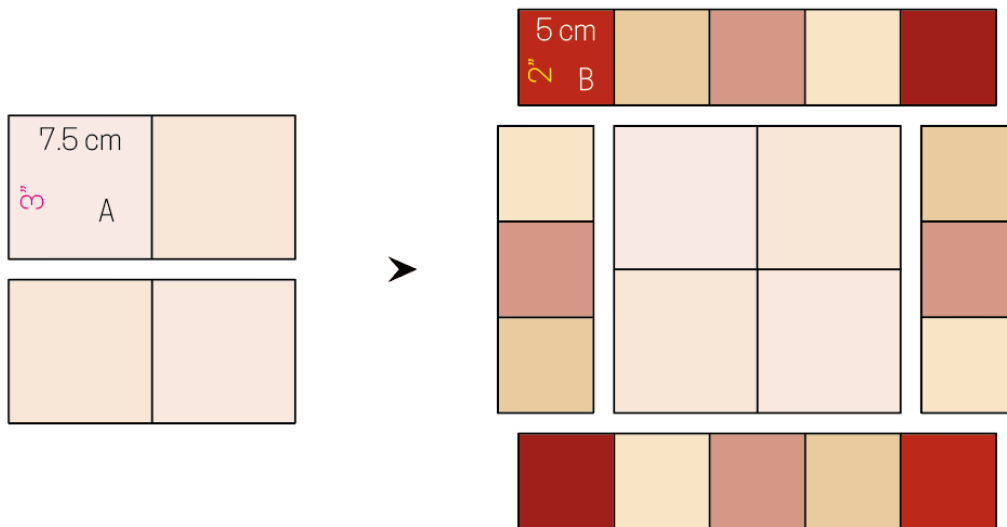


Diagram 2: Stitch the C and C' pieces to either side of the D piece. Work the appliqué using the traditional method as follows: pin or baste the heart obtained in the centre of the block, turning your seam allowances to the back. Then appliqué the heart with small invisible stitches.
