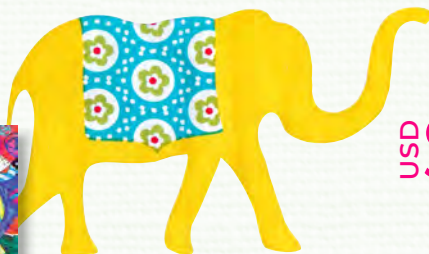

**Chris Jurd** is an Australian artist who is passionate about original prints in vibrant colours, using them with flare in her pieced, geometric quilts.

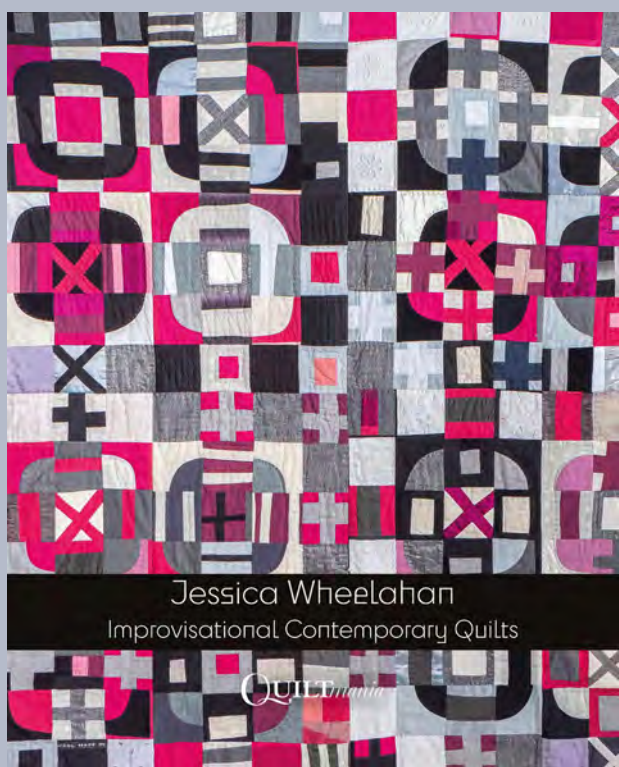
